



**Community Health-In-Partnership Services (CHIPS)
Position Description**

CLUB CHIPS Student Youth Leader/Peer Health Educator

Status: Part-time

Responsible to: CLUB CHIPS Program Coordinator

Description: This is a one to four year paid training program in the performing arts and health education. Ideally, students will join CLUB CHIPS in their freshman or sophomore year of high school.

- Activities include after school classes and rehearsals at least two days a week during school year.
- Occasional weekend workshops during school year to refine skills, and presentations at special events.
- Occasional performances during the school day with permission from student's principal.
- Summer classes, rehearsals and performances 20 hours a week for 8 weeks.

Students between the ages of 14 – 18 will work with professional writers, actors, choreographers, theatre technicians, visual artists, health care and other professionals to write and produce touring caliber musical theatre productions focusing on health care and social issues pertinent to youth.

Qualifications:

1. A full time high school student in good academic standing.
2. Has a healthy lifestyle and is a good role model.
3. Good communication and reading and writing skills.
4. Flexible and able to prioritize tasks. Willing to take on special assignments.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist in creating and updating original plays and workshops.
- Responsible for all aspects of the setup, operation and break down of the set, props, costumes and sound equipment needed to perform the plays.
- Ability to take direction and work independently on learning lines, dances, music and the health care information that is the subject of the presentations.
- Students will function as peer educators giving basic health care information to their other youth and directing them to specific resources for more focused help.
- Occasional other duties as assigned including community activities that can include gardening, campus clean-up, office work at CHIPS.

Compensation: Hourly stipend is comparable to minimum wage paid once every two weeks for hours worked.
